

Report a Flood Risk

If you wish to report a flood risk to property or the public please provide the information below. This will enable us to investigate the situation and where appropriate seek measures to avoid or mitigate the risk.

Please provide all information to the following questions so that we have a clear understanding of the situation.

- Whereabouts is the location of the flood risk?
(provide a mark up on the map on page 2, or provide map co-ordinates)
- What do you believe is the cause of the flood risk?
 - The effects of extreme periods of rainfall?
 - Surface water flooding
 - River or watercourse overflowing
 - Groundwater level flooding
 - A blockage of a river or watercourse?
 - Do you know who the riparian owner is?
 - Have you spoken to the riparian owner about this?
- How imminent is the risk of flooding at this location?
 - Already a flood risk; or Likely to be a flood risk soon.
- Is the flood risk a flooding threat to property?
 - If so – what is the address, and who is the owner?
 - Have flood protective measures being taken by the owner?
- Is the flood risk likely to be a danger to the public?

There is a section of the Ashton Keynes Parish Council website www.akpc.org.uk which has a lot of information about planning for an expected flooding event, and what measures property owners can take.

Please note that riparian owners are responsible for the maintenance of rivers, watercourses, and ditches, and not the Parish Council or Flood Risk Working Group.
