

Councillor Vacancy

Following recent elections, the Parish Council has one vacancy remaining.

Local councils work towards improving community well-being and providing better services. Their activities fall into three main categories: representing the local community; delivering services to meet local needs; striving to improve quality of life and community well-being. If this is something that you are interested in and you can spare a few hours every month, please contact either the Clerk or the Chair.

To qualify as a councillor, a person must be a British subject aged over 18 years old and an elector, must reside in or within 3 miles of the Ashton Keynes Parish Boundary or occupy as owner or tenant any land or premises therein, or have their principal or only place of work there and must not be disqualified from holding office as a councillor.

The Parish Council are looking to Co-opt at its next meeting which will be held on 14th July.
